How Does the UK Perceive Christianity?

Recently the Barna Group did a survey based on the **“Perceptions of Jesus, Christians and Evangelism in the United Kingdom.”**

The world has often viewed the UK as a Christian stronghold and historically this is true. However, over the last few decades the United Kingdom could now be considered post-Christian. The most striking statement we found in the article was, “But even though most UK adults believe Jesus was a



historical person, they are much less convinced of his divinity. In fact, belief in Jesus’ divinity is not common at all. **Only about one in five adults among the general population holds the orthodox belief that Jesus was ‘God in human form who lived among people in the 1st Century’ (22%).**” They went on to say that “The most common belief about Jesus is that He was ‘a prophet or spiritual leader, not God’ (29%).” So what does this all mean?

It means that we have a lot of work to do. It also means the opportunities for the Gospel in London are endless. With the right plan and an authentic Christian witness (which is often lacking), London could once again be a beacon for the Gospel of Jesus Christ.

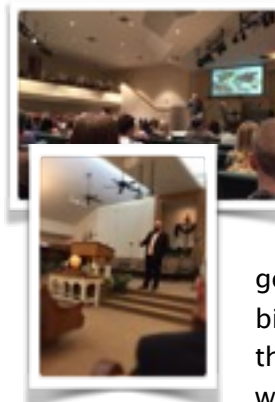
Our Kids Are A Big Part of Our Ministry!
